10.30am	Start making our way down to the Strand via the rose gardens and the redoubt.
11.15am	Photograph along the waterfront. Features include the wharf, the canoe, railway lines, Hairy Mac Leary statues, etc
12.00pm	Stop for lunch
1.30pm	Carry on down the rest of the waterfront, along the boardwalk to the railway bridge
2.30pm	Start making our way back up to the Elms via town and the old Post Office
